Historical context is much more than a listing of events. Historical context is more about the issues that surround an event than the event itself. The following questions are important to consider when analyzing historical context.

- What happened before the event?
- What happened after the event (short and long term effects)?
- What was the political situation at the time?
- What were the cultural beliefs of the time?
- What was the economic situation of the time?
